The website located at tampafineleaves.com (the "Website") is operated by Tampa Fine Leaves, LLC (hereinafter may be referred to as "us," "we," and "our").

We are committed to respecting your privacy so this Privacy Policy describes how your personal information is collected, used, transferred, and processed when you visit or engage with the Website.

By using this Website, you consent to our Privacy Policy set forth below. We reserve the right to modify the terms of this Privacy Policy at any time and in our sole discretion, by posting a change notice on this page. Continued use of the Website following a change notice constitutes your acceptance of those changes. For more information about our privacy practices, if you have questions, or if you would like to make a complaint, please contact us using the contact form on our Website.

1. SCOPE. We are incorporated in the United States of America and as such we are subject to the laws of the United States of America. While our level of privacy protection may not be as great as that offered in other jurisdictions, we comply with the laws of the United States of America when it comes to transferring, storing, or processing your data. By using our Website, you understand and consent to the collection, storage, processing, and transfer of your data in our American facilities and other terms as described in this Privacy Policy.

2. PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT. When you visit the Website, we automatically collect certain information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and some of the cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Website, we collect information about the individual web pages, products and/or services that you view, what webpages or search terms referred you to our Website, and information about how you interact with our Website. We refer to this automaticallycollected information as "Device Information."

We collect Device Information using the following technologies: (1) "Cookies" are data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier. For more information about cookies, and how to disable cookies, visit <u>http://www.allaboutcookies.org</u>; (2) "Log files" track actions occurring on the Website, and collect data including your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, referring/exit pages, and date/time stamps; (3) "Web beacons," "tags," and "pixels" are electronic files used to record information about how you browse the Site.

As applicable, when you make a purchase or attempt to make a purchase through the Website, we collect certain information from you, including your name, billing address, shipping address, payment information (including credit card numbers), email address, and phone number. We refer to this information as "Order Information."

When we talk about "Personal Information" in this Privacy Policy, we are talking about Device Information, Order Information, and information voluntarily shared with us via our forms. The collection of this Personal Information enables us to provide you with the assistance and/or products you have requested through the Website.

Further, as applicable, you subscribe you are communicating with us electronically. You consent to receive electronic response(s) from us or those thirdparties you are trying to connect with that we work with on our Website, as may be applicable.

3. How WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION. We use the Device Information that we collect to help us screen for potential risk and fraud (in particular, your IP address), and more generally to improve and optimize our Website (for example, by generating analytics about how our customers browse and interact with the Website, and to assess the success of our marketing and advertising campaigns).

We use Personal Information that we collect when you fill out forms to communicate with you about requested products.

As applicable, we use the Order Information that we collect generally to fulfill any orders placed through the Website (including processing your payment information, arranging for shipping, and providing you with invoices and/or order confirmations). Additionally, we use this Order Information to: Communicate with you; Screen our orders for potential risk or fraud; and When in line with the preferences you have shared with

us, provide you with information or advertising relating to our products or services.

4. SHARING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION. We may share your Personal Information with third parties to help us execute orders. We will never sell, rent, or lease your Personal Information to a third party. We may also use a shipping provider to prepare and send your shipment, as well as payment processors, like PayPal or Square, to process your payment.

We may disclose your Personal Information to comply with a court order, subpoena, search warrant, or other legal process; to comply with legal, regulatory, or administrative requirements of any governmental authorities; to protect and defend Tampa Fine Leaves, LLC, its subsidiaries and affiliates, and their officers, directors, employees, attorneys, agents, contractors, and partners, in connection with any legal action, claim, or dispute; to enforce the Terms of the website; to prevent imminent physical harm; and in the event that we find that your actions on the website violate any laws.

We reserve the right to transfer your Personal Information to a third party in the event of a transfer of all or substantially all of Tampa Fine Leaves, LLC assets.

5. THIRD-PARTIES. We may contract with third parties to maintain and host the Website and/or process payments as referenced above. Any information you submit to us, including Personal Information, may be placed and stored on a computer server maintained by this third-party host.

Further, we may utilize third-party links on our Website for your convenience. These links are third-party owner and operated. You should review their individual privacy policies before use. We make no representation that their policies comply with ours as set forth herein.

6. BEHAVIORAL ADVERTISING. As described above, we use your Personal Information to provide you with targeted advertisements or marketing communications we believe may be of interest to you. 11. MINORS. The Website is not intended for individuals under the age of twenty-one (21). We do not knowingly collect information, including Personal Information, from children or other individuals who are not legally able to use our Website and products.

12. SAFE HARBOR. We adhere to the U.S. safe harbor policy privacy principles of notice, choice, onward transfer, security, data integrity, access, and enforcement.
